

TABERNACLE BAPTIST CHURCH HISTORY FROM 1923 - 2023

THE BEGINNING

In 1922, a small group gathered to worship. They met in the home of the late Booker T. Williams, 308 E. Federal St, Burlington, NJ. With growth, they moved to the Clarkson St Hall & decided to form a church. To that end, Rev. Wesley L. Gregory, Lindsay Gregory, John Burroughs, Fred Lang, Tilson Williams, William Mack Burroughs, Vanderbilt Burroughs and Henry Neilson joined Second Baptist, Mt Holly, NJ (The Mother Church) & received letters of transfer: The name "Tabernacle" was suggested by Sallie E. Walton and the Permanent Council of the Bethany Baptist Assoc. of South Jersey later recognized the mission as "Tabernacle Baptist Church" which was established in 1923. Under the leadership of the 1st Pastor, Rev Wesley L. Gregory, the Church became affiliated with the Nat'l Baptist Convention in 1932. On 2nd Sunday, June 10, 1923, the 1st official service with communion was held in the Grange Hall on Stacy Street. Official boards were established in addition to: the Senior Choir, Church School, Missionary Circle, & the Usher Board. The Deacon Board was formed and consisted of: Feddis Walton Sr. (Chairman), Julius Sheilley, Lee Allen & Tilson Williams. The first deacons ordained were: Otis Butts, Sr., James Jones, Thomas Burroughs, Sr., Fred Lang and Deacon West. The Trustee Board was also formed with: Thomas Burroughs, Sr. (Chairman), Philip Price (Vice Chair), Booker T. Williams, Roosevelt Brown and Feddis Walton, Jr. The Senior Choir was organized in November 1923 at the home of the late Mr. Booker T. Williams, with choir director, Mr. Inous Walton (who also served as President) and Ruth Bolden Goodwin (Pianist). The TBC School was organized under Mr. Inous Walton with Vanderbilt Williams. Deacon Tilson Williams was appointed the 1st. Superintendent, while Inous Walton and Irene Walton Means were teachers. The first Missionary Circle was organized under Sallie Walton, with Annie Gregory (First Lady) as the President. Lillie Butts, Annie West and Minnie Lee Allen were among its first members and Tilson Williams, Vanderbilt Burroughs, Henry Schonyers, Ananias Jones and John Burroughs served as the first Usher Board. Bessie R. Burroughs (an original member), remained active until her passing in January 1994.

PERIOD OF PROMISE & STRUGGLE

As the church grew, a larger edifice was needed. In less than a year, members triumphantly marched from Grange Hall on Stacy St. into the almost completed structure on E. Second St. (the same site we occupy today). However, DISASTER visited this fledgling church in 1938 when the church was virtually destroyed by FIRE. Services were then held temporarily in the basement of the Allen School on Wall St. In the ensuing years, the wheels of progress changed the design of the City of Burlington. The improvements and redevelopment plans by the "City" left the church situated in the "Heart of the City." Consequently, in June 1957, the church and other areas on E. Second St. were destroyed by the FLOODS. Funerals and other services were held elsewhere.

PASTORIUM

Under the leadership of the late Rev. Gregory, (13 years), TBC soon became one of the leading sanctuaries in the City of Burlington for all. It was after Rev. Gregory that the fellowship hall was named and it was in 1936, he was later called to a pastor a church in Jamaica, NY. He was followed by Rev. J. J. Young and Rev. W. H. Holman, who both served 1 year. They were followed by Rev. J. H. Stafford and Rev. V. L. Millines, who served 5 years, respectively. They were then followed by, Rev. Pompey H. Houston, who also served for 13 years. In 1961, Rev. Richard Wise Jones was called to be the new pastor. He came with his wife, Ethel B. Jones. They settled in Burlington from Cape May, NJ with 2 daughters, Leslie and Jennifer. During his tenure, the church saw exponential growth, and under his leadership, the church completed 4 building phases culminating, with the Christian Ed. wing and Unity Hall. Rev. Jones served for 49 years until his death on June 18, 2010. It was at that time, Deacon Robert Preston (Chairman), led the church from June 2010 to 2011 with a steady hand. On Jan. 1, 2012, Deacon Willie Reid was installed as Chairman. On Sept. 25, 2012, Rev. Dr. Cory LeRoy Jones was called to serve as the 8th pastor of TBC and in his official role as Pastor -Elect, he preached his 1st sermon on Communion Sunday, Dec. 9, 2012. He was installed, April 14, 2013 and is affectionately known as "Pastor Cory". Academically, Pastor Cory received a BA from the Univ. of California, Berkeley, and a Master of Divinity from Morehouse School of Religion at the Interdenominational Theological Center and a Doctor of Ministry from Beeson Divinity School at Samford University. A native of LA, Pastor Cory was licensed to preach by Dr. Melvin V. Wade Sr. at the Mt. Moriah Baptist Church. He then served the Greater St. Paul Baptist Church of Oakland as a Youth Pastor and transitioned to the Jackson Memorial Baptist Church of Atlanta as Assist. Pastor. He has a beautiful family and is the husband of Deborah Jones, proud father of daughter, Dakota Aubree and son (his name sake), affectionately known to us as C.J. Under Pastor Cory's leadership, TBC continues to grow. He expanded the church's charity outreach both locally and internationally and in 2013, Hallelujah HYPE Night for the youth was established. On Aug.15, 2017, Pastor Cory became the 1st keynote speaker from TBC to address the Lott Carey Convention at the 120th session in Birmingham, AL In 2021, he initiated an Expungement Clinic at TBC, and in 2022, he was honored with the Faith Fighters Award, followed by being inducted into the Martin Luther King Jr. College of Ministers and Laity Morehouse College in Atlanta, GA.

GROWTH AND EXPANSION

As membership grew, an expansion was necessary and on Sunday, August 26, 1967, a groundbreaking ceremony was held. On Sunday, June 2, 1968, the members triumphantly entered a new sanctuary (located next to the old one) and it was incorporated in 1965. In 1984, the old sanctuary was demolished to make room for the new educational wing which was completed in 1985. However, as the need arose, the educational wing, was enlarged, modified, and affectionately named the Jones Educational Wing. It was then In Nov., 1994, the congregation marched into a New 1500 seat capacity Sanctuary. On June 7, 2008, connected to the church on E. Second & James St., "Unity Hall", was dedicated introducing a new state of the art 25,000 square foot multi-purpose building which includes: a full sized gymnasium (w/ a basketball court), a performance stage (w/ dressing rooms), an exercise area (w/ showers & lockers) & a cafeteria (w/ a full kitchen/ banquet area), to accommodate seating in excess of 300+.

PERFORMING ARTS MINISTRY

Over the years, TBC has been blessed with inspirational music, dance & theater performances: Gospel Chorus (1940); Young Adult Choir (1942); Children's Choir (1969); Male Chorus (1973); Women's Chorus (1977), Fellowship Choir (1987), & the Praise Team (1999), Praise Dance (2000), Drama Ministry, Tabernacle Players (2007). In 2013, the Music Ministry was restructured & in 2016, the Senior Choir, Gospel Choir and Women's Choir were combined to form the Sanctuary Choir & the Mass Choir was formed combining members from all the music ministries. The Performing Arts Ministry, is presently led by Professor Craig Hayes (8 years).

SERVICE & EDUCATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

The Baptist Training Union (BTU) started @ TBC as Baptist Young People's Union (BYPU). The Union was organized in 1954 to give young people a more in-depth study of God's Word. In 1965, the Union was renamed Baptist Training Union (BTU). In 2015, BTU was renamed CBS (Contemporary Bible Study). In 1989, The Board of Christian Ed. was established with Barbara Pearson (as the 1st. Director) and the church Library expanded. Additional TBC Ministries are: Adult Willing Workers, formerly The Adult Club (1946); Pastor's Aide (1954); Junior Ushers (1960); Men's Ministry, formerly Men of Tabernacle(1963); Progressive Guild (1968); Nurses' Unit (1971); QUEST - Christian Outreach (1977); School of Christian Discipleship (2004); Tabernacle Doorkeepers (2007); Greeters Ministry (2011); Jr. Missionary (2012): Congregational Fitness (2013): SHINE was restructured and renamed H.Y.P.E. (His Youth Positioned for Excellence) which established Youth Church and The Vacation Bible School (VBS) was opened to members of all ages; The first Associate Ministry Conference was held in 2014; Save Our Seniors (SOS-2018); L.I.G.H.T. (Living in God's Hope Today); Funeral Team (2014); Culinary Team (2016); and LEVELS (2017). Also in 2017, The Church School and School of Christian Discipleship were merged to form Cross Training. Solace Ministry and L.I.G.H.T. were combined to form Compassion Ministry. In 2019, Transformational Week of Study was developed (traditionally held the 1st week of Jan). Quest established a Soup kitchen which is open each Monday from 12 noon to 2:00 p.m. In 2013, TBC Mission Ministry founded the "Garden of Hope Community School" in Ghana, West Africa. In 2016, Tabernacle Baptist Church collected water for Flint, Michigan. In 2022, donations/goods were collected and delivered to aid the Mississippi Water Crisis. In 2020, TBC partnered with Virtua Hospital to provide CO-VID Testing and later offered COVID vaccines to over 3000 people.

CO-VID 19 PANDEMIC

In Jan. 2020, the COVID-19 pandemic struck the United States resulting in sickness and many deaths. As a result, in March 2020, all non-essential businesses and churches were closed. TBC closed for indoor worship on March 8, 2020 remaining closed until June 13, 2021. At that time, worship in the sanctuary was cut to one service at 10:00 a.m. with inperson attendance being limited to 250 mask wearing members whose temperatures were taken at the door. Fortunately, service & bible study continued via Livestream providing uninterrupted service for all with internet connections. By God's grace, TBC members remained faithful and utilized on-line giving, mail or dropped off donations in person via the church. After a decrease in Covid cases in person worship resumed, only to close again due to a mutation of the virus. In person worship finally resumed February 13, 2022. Today, June of 2023, we are open for worship with one service at 10am with the return of over 600 attendees and a strong online presence.

Through it all, we confidently echo the sentiments of our forefathers when we sing, "We've come this far by faith, leaning on the Lord; Trusting in His Holy Word, He has never failed us yet." Yet, we acknowledge, in order to have an Impactful Ministry to move forward, we must "Take Off the Masks to See Greater" and see ourselves as God sees us, "A Chosen People of Royal Priesthood, a Consecrated Nation, and God's Own Possession" using what we have learned from the past while embracing innovation & technology to propel us into the next 100 years for he has, "Taken us out of Darkness and into the Marvelous Light" I Peter 2: 9-10.
